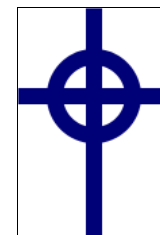

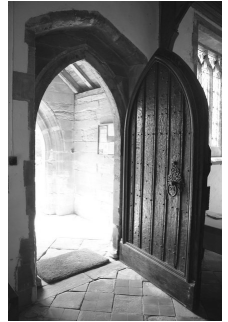


All Saints' Church continues to open twice a week
