## This Sunday is the final day of One World Week (18th-25th October) This year's theme is: Working together for a just, peaceful and sustainable world: it's our world, let's make it better.

In normal years we have had a One World Week Traidcraft Stall and a One World Lunch together. This year that cannot happen.

The Traidcraft shop is available online for Christmas cards and other items at traidcraftshop.co.uk Traidcraft is a pioneer in promoting Social Justice, Trade Justice and Environmental Justice through the sales of Fairtrade goods, mostly from poorer countries overseas.

#### Collection for USPG (United Society for Partners in the Gospel)

On Sunday 25th there will be a plate at the back of All Saints' Church for donations to USPG as a mark of our support in One World Week. USPG supports church communities throughout the world. USPG sends us prayer diaries and the magazine *Koinonia*. "Koinonia" means fellowship or communion, usually of a Christian group. It suggests the fellowship and unity that should exist within Christianity. Koinonia comes from Greek and the first occurrence of the word in the New Testament is in Acts 2:42, "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer."


