All Saints: Sunday, 1st November at 5pm and again on **Monday 2nd November at 12noon**

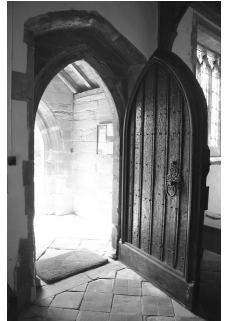
Please do join us at one of these services, and please let me know if you are able to help in any way – stewarding, reading, helping with lighting candles, etc.

"I was phoned by somebody claiming to be P.C. claiming to be from the Met. She gave her name and number. Apparently my Visa Debit card had been used to draw £600+ in the South London area. She asked me to ring 999, but first she played 2 Beeps. Then she told me to ring 999 when I'd heard the beeps. (VERY SUSPICIOUS.) I put the phone down and rang the police on my mobile and spoke to West Mercia police who were aware of this kind of case. I had a follow-up visit from a policeman.
