Green Homes Voucher Scheme

The Green Homes Voucher Scheme opened on 30th September 2020 and is a government scheme which can be accessed via the Simple Energy Advice website (this site also includes more information): https://www.simpleenergyadvice.org.uk/

The government will provide a voucher that covers up to two thirds of the cost of qualifying improvements installing energy efficient or low energy improvements to your home. The maximum value of the voucher is £5,000. You may be able to receive a higher level of subsidy if you are a homeowner and either you or a member of your household receives one of the qualifying benefits, covering 100% of the cost of the improvements. The maximum value of these vouchers is £10,000. Private rented properties cannot receive the 'low income' vouchers up to £10,000. The deadline for works to be completed is March 31st 2021. Anyone needing help and guidance about this government scheme can contact the council's energy advice service, delivered by YES Energy Solution
