Wednesday Morning Services have started back at 10.00 am in the Ruth Heald Room. Morning Worship will be held on the 1st, 2nd and 4th Wednesdays and Holy Communion on

the 3rd Wednesdays.

We will be socially distanced and are required to stay seated throughout the service and until you leave. Please wear a face mask; Anti Bac gel will be available and you are required to sign the register.

A hot drink will be available afterwards. It will be good to have this service again after such a long break.

Our Tuesday Walks will now meet on 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of every month. The next walk will be on 27th July at 10am returning at 12 noon for refreshments.

Government Legislation

The Government is proposing a new piece of legislation that would put a counter-terrorism obligation on all places of worship, and especially on those whose capacities exceed 100 people. The easiest way to meet the obligations under the proposed legislation is to keep our churches closed.

The Archdeacon of London has written a very helpful blog on this that I encourage everyone to read. A consultation on the legislation is underway and there is a link in the following piece if you wish to respond.

Whilst there is some logic to the legislation for places such as the National Gallery, its impact on the smallest of our churches could be extremely onerous and will lead many small rural churches to lock their doors.
