## PRAYERS FOR UKRAINE / OPENING of CHURCH

The situation in Ukraine is ever more

serious and our prayers for all involved are urgently needed. To facilitate this, and in recognition that the broader community may welcome more access to our churches, we are trying to keep St Godwald's open throughout the week between approximately 9am and 4pm.
