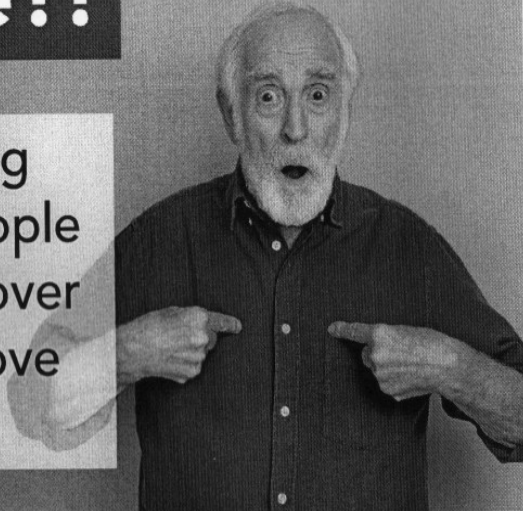

The theme is “*God’s Church for God’s World*” - walking, listening and witnessing together, and the conference will explore what it means for the Anglican Communion to be responsive to the needs of the 21st century world. The Biblical focus will be on the Book of 1 Peter.

We are asked to join the bishops in prayer and to commit ourselves at the same time:

Gracious God, we thank you that in Jesus you reconcile the world and all who are in it to yourself.

Touch the hearts of those attending the Lambeth Conference to extend your peace to all, and to work for the reconciliation of all creation.

Bless them with your grace and love as they connect with one another and with you.

May your Spirit of peace hover over their conversations and their resting times,

and may your gracious will be done in the life of the Anglican Communion and in the whole of your precious world.

May we, too, commit ourselves to work for the reconciliation of all creation.
