ST BASILS' BIG SLEEPOUT: THANK YOU!

Thank you to everyone who supported us with the Big Sleepout for St Basils (<https://stbasils.enthuse.com/pf/uob-llr>) on Friday 28th November: Your support has really been appreciated.

The evening was quite an experience. Although we didn't get a lot of sleep, the weather was a little milder than we had expected (although hats, gloves and multiple layers were still required in our sleeping bags!). We awoke to heavy rain on Saturday morning, but amazingly our boxes remained relatively watertight and survived the wind earlier in the night.

We were well looked after by St Basils, including curry on Friday night, hot drinks and an hour's festive entertainment by the West Midlands Fire Service Brass Band. At 10pm we had a presentation from St Basils' CEO which was very uplifting and gave numerous examples of how their work is benefitting young people. They showed us a video of their new accommodation unit near Snow Hill station which allows young people a much cheaper than market value room, often for 6-24 months, to enable them to get settled into work, and to make it beneficial to work. Perhaps the most heartfelt moment of the evening was when one of the young people who had benefitted from St Basils' support, came on stage and recited a poem that he had written about his experiences.

Thanks again for your support and do ask us when you see us if you would like to know more - we're very happy to talk about the experience!
