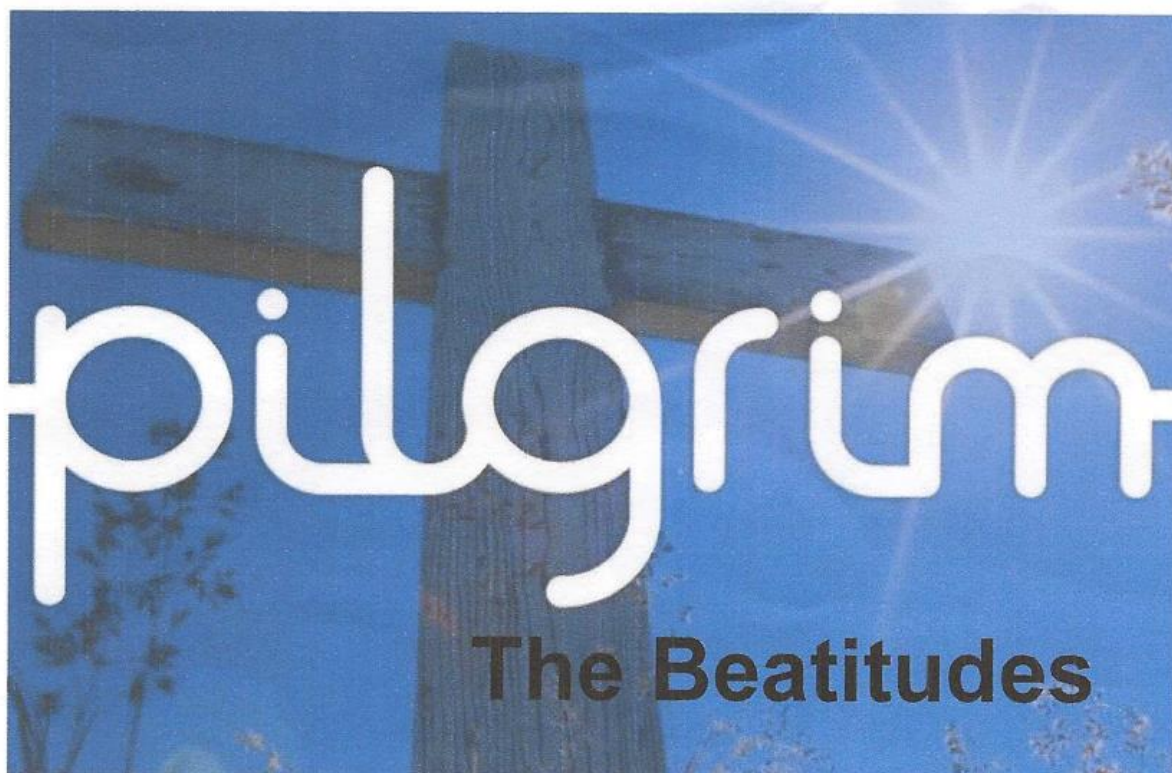

HOW TO KEEP WELL-HYDRATED from Dr Paddy Blacker

In this very hot weather, we are being urged to stay well hydrated by drinking plenty. There are many proprietary drinks available in the shops but here is a recipe that was recommended by the World Health Organisation to populations that were prone to dehydrating conditions.

It is a very simple solution at minimum cost with the ingredients being available in most people's homes.

In a large container add 1 pint (500 mL) of clean cold water.

Add four heaped teaspoons full of sugar (not sweetener!) Half a teaspoonful of salt and the juice of half a lemon (optional but makes it taste much better). Stir well until the salt and sugar have been dissolved and drink freely. The solution is not recommended for diabetics.

Keep unused solution in the fridge and make a large jug of it using the same proportions if required. This is a much less expensive rehydration drink than those of the "sports variety" and to my mind it tastes an awful lot better.

While I was in practice I recommended it to many of my patients with beneficial results.

All Saints' magazine archive helps document the church's history. We are looking into binding (and possibly digitising) the archive from 1950 to when it concludes in the mid-2010s both for preservation and to allow easier access to the material. Before binding, we are keen to ensure the archive is as complete as possible and so we are appealing to anyone who may still have copies of the magazines.

We are particularly keen to hear from anyone who has copies of any of the magazines published between 1965 and 1989 inclusive.
